

**FAQ 10:**

***If I go to the drop zone on the 10<sup>th</sup> hole, hit my ball, then after hitting it a second time it goes into the penalty area to the left of the fairway, where can I take relief.***

**Answer:**

Since this area is marked with yellow stakes with green tops it is a no-play zone, and since it is almost certainly impossible to position yourself not nearer the hole on a line connecting the point where the ball crossed the boundary of the no-play zone and the hole, you have two options.

Option 1: take “stroke and distance” relief and play a ball from where you previously played the ball that is in the no-play zone.

Option 2: go back to the drop zone and play the ball from there.

Both these options incur a 1-stroke penalty.
