

## CRISS-CROSS

	DESCRIPTION
Format	Criss-Cross is not a competition per se; rather it is a scoring system that can be applied to a variety of competitions. However it only makes sense to use it on competitions that utilise Stableford, Bogey or Net (to PAR) scoring, not Gross.

The idea behind "Criss-Cross" is that, at the end of the round you compare the (Stableford, Bogey or Net) score on each hole on the front-9 with the score on the corresponding hole on the back-9 and select the better of the two scores e.g.

- if the Stableford score on hole 1 was 3 points, while that on hole 10 was a 1, then you would amend the score on hole 10 to 3 points;
- if the Bogey score on hole 9 was '+', while that on hole 18 was '-', then you would amend the score on hole 18 to '+'.
- if the Net to PAR score on hole 2 was -1 point, while that on hole 11 was +3, then you would amend the score on hole 11 to -1 points;

After you have made the amendments check that the score on the front-9 is equal to that on the back-9. If they are not equal you have made a mistake that you need to find and correct.
